STATE OF AFFAIRS OF THE COOPERATION WITH THE ARAB UNION OF LAND TRANSPORT (AULT)

The 29th Meeting of the BSEC-URTA General Assembly in Bucharest on 26 May 2016 granted Observer Status to the Arab Union of Land Transport (AULT) on reciprocity basis.

A High Level AULT/BSEC-URTA Bilateral Meeting was held in Beirut on 4-5 September 2016 in order to lay out main principles and framework for bilateral cooperation.

AULT and BSEC-URTA Secretaries General met in Istanbul on 22 September 2016 and elaborated a comprehensive Action Plan for AULT/BSEC-URTA Bilateral Cooperation in 2016-2017, which should be approved by the competent organs of both Organisations.

The abovementioned Action Plan is given in the attached table.

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OPERATIVE ARTICLES OF AULT / BSEC-URTA MoU (*)

Article 1) Main Objectives

The Parties, taking into consideration their respective Statutes/Constitutions, have agreed to strengthen co-operation between the two organisations, especially but not limited to the key areas of promoting sustainable development of the road transport of passengers and goods; improving exchange of information and expertise between their membership; supporting and promoting regional efforts and developments aimed at improving road safety; supporting multilateral cooperation to designate common problems and find common solutions and thus maintaining seamless flow of trade over the borders.

The Parties will develop their bilateral cooperation in parallel to their main regional priorities and inter-regional needs as well as common elements of their existing cooperation under the aegis of IRU.

Article 2) Areas of Cooperation and Consultation

The Parties will keep each other informed on matters of common interest and may hold consultations on the issues of cooperation. The Parties may at such intervals as deemed appropriate, convene meetings to review the progress of activities and studies, and plan future activities. Parties may arrange common orientation seminars for their members, mutually or jointly.

The Parties will consider favourable to carry out joint projects, organise conferences, regional events, seminars, workshops and exhibitions on trade and road transport facilitation, road safety, professional qualification and any other topical issue of common interest, if need be in cooperation with key regional partners, governments and other relevant organisations, in compliance with the financial and organisational rules of procedure established for both organisations.

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
