

#### 6<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF THE BSEC-URTA AD HOC WORKING PARTY ON INSURANCE

TOBB Plaza Istanbul, Turkey Wednesday, 7 February 2018, at 10:00 hrs

#### **REPORT**

The 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of the BSEC-URTA *ad hoc* Working Party on Insurance was held at the premises of TOBB Plaza in Istanbul on 7 February 2018.

BSEC-URTA Members, Observers, IRU, invited insurance companies as well as the representative of Russian law company URVEST participated in the meeting.

The list of participants is given in **Annex 1**.

#### **Background**

The 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Working Party took place in Istanbul on 28 August 2017 with the participation of BSEC-URTA Member Associations and invited insurance companies as well as the representative of Reinsurance Company Swiss Re.

In conclusion, at its fifth meeting, the Working Party agreed as follows:

- 1. RGS with the support of Swiss Re will prepare the summary description of the terms and conditions of the Product and send this description together with the Agreement of confidentiality to the potential participants chosen for the survey in 5 different countries.
- 2. The Product should be presented by insurance companies participants of the WPI in 5 different countries to 5-6 road carriers representative of various sectors of road transport industry starting from small private companies with 1-3 trucks and finishing by the big companies with more than 100 trucks.
- 3. RGS will give all the documents, questionnaires and very clear instructions to local insurance companies about the questions which should be asked and of expecting results of the survey, including the survey of what additional services the carriers want and what they are willing to pay for. Some questions should be asked about the potential network of services agents (Associations, Insurance companies, internal providers).
- 4. Insurance Companies participants of WPI also should provide BSEC-URTA with the information in respect of IT-Platform. The IT-Platform should be in the BSEC-URTA, but the connections should be in each country.
- 5. Hold the sixth meeting for elaboration of concrete steps for creating the single regional insurance product.

Also, on its 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting, the BSEC-URTA General Assembly took note of the Report of the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Working Party on Insurance as well as verbal report of the WPI Chairperson Ms. Natalia Polunina, informing about recent developments of co-developing regional CMR product with the participation of Swiss Re. It was decided to hold the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Working Party with participation of insurance companies in order to detalize the parameters of new regional CMR product.

#### Summary of the 6th Meeting

BSEC-URTA President Ms. Asli Gozutok and Honorary President Mr. Vladimir Florea delivered their opening remarks and Chairperson Ms. Natalia Polunina chaired the meeting welcoming all the participants.

Then, the floor was given to the representative of URVEST Law Firm Mr. Roman Obraztsov who shared his *presentation about URVEST*, its services, scope and benefits for the carriers (**Annex 2**). He also gave the examples of cooperation methods of solving law suits in Europe, EAEU, CIS, BSEC countries,

patterns of possible work with BSEC-URTA and its Members and Observers as well as answered the questions of the participants.

Then the Chairperson Ms. Natalia Polunina took the flour. She noted that as a result of the surveys done the carries in the region showed the high interest to such kind of service which was asked about in questionnaire. Main problems are: IT-platform characteristics and promotion of the insurance product. The beginning may be set with Moldova, Georgia (+ Azerbaijan). The details on responsibilities, organizational and legal steps are described in the *CMR* + *Project Presentation* (Annex 3).

Outline of technical task is determined in IT Platform Example Presentation (Annex 4).

Participants agreed that in order to push the establishment and presentation of the regional CMR+ Product, the following steps should be done.

#### **Next steps and further actions:**

- 1) Clarification with Swiss Re possibility of including Turkey into the CMR+ Pilot Project.
- 2) Market search for evaluation of proposals on creation of IT-platform.
- 3) Technical analysis and elaboration of Financial Plan for IT-platform and generally for the CMR+ Project.
- 4) After 3-4 countries are determined for participation in the CMR+ Pilot Project and concrete steps in creation of IT-platform are elaborated the International Secretariat submits to the IRU fund for financial support. As B Plan be ready to elaborate other mechanisms of searching donors/investors such as BSTDB.
- 5) Elaborate the Road Map for CMR+ initiative with duly written steps, and then approve it on the 33rd Meeting of the BSEC-URTA General Assembly, which will be held on 8 June 2018 in Sofia, Bulgaria.
- 6) Preparation of legal basis, regulatory documents (like MoU, agreements etc.) between BSEC-URTA, Associations and insurers and reinsures.
- 7) Hold intermediate meeting(s) for comprehensive work on CMR+ Project (coordinational, organizational, technical, legal etc. issues) for better readiness to present it on the 33<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the BSEC-URTA General Assembly.

#### **Next Meeting**

The Working Party agreed that Chairperson will announce venue and date of its next meeting in consultation with the International Secretariat after review all necessary steps.

Characteristics	Description
Who will use?	<ol> <li>Hauliers from different countries (on the first stage BSEC States, over the long term - other states) for registration of insurance policy (certificate) for CMR liability insurance (single/standardized insurance product for all the countries)</li> <li>Call-Centre or insurance company representative, service agent for checking the availability of insurance certificate from the applying carrier</li> </ol>
How to enter?	Through the web-site of Associations or through the BSEC-URTA site. To enter by means of search engines is IMPOSSIBLE!!!
Policy Payment	On-line, with the use of different methods (bank cards, web-money etc.)
Language	Main one – English, with the opportunity to turn to other languages (Turkish, Rumanian, Russian).

# **Electronic Platform for Selling Insurance Policies**


Characteristics	Description
Technology	<ol> <li>Haulier enters the web-site</li> <li>Chooses the necessary language</li> <li>Chooses the necessary company (most often from his own country)</li> <li>Enters the necessary parameters for entering into an insurance policy (certificate)</li> <li>Pays the policy (the fee is composed as follows: one vehicle insurance fee per year X amount of vehicles)</li> <li>After payment is done (the payment should be reflected on the account of the relevant insurance company) – the certificate is sent by e-mail to the carrier or is printed out</li> <li>The original policy is sent to the insurance company by courier mail to the address specified by the carrier</li> </ol>

# **Electronic Platform for Selling Insurance Policies**

Characteristics	Description
Is there use to save the information?	Yes, it's necessary to foresee the possibility for archiving the following data:  - Applications (declarations)  - Issued policies (certificates)  - Notification of insurance claims  - Service requests
Accounting and Control	Once a month on the bases of Platform data the bordereau (list) is composed:  - Written out policies (certificates) per each insurance company  - Notification of insurance claims
How to notify the insurance claims?	Pre-notification of the insurance case (event/ accident) is proceeded by means of Platform and is redirected to the relevant insurance company (one which issued the policy).
How to apply for services?	Application for services can be done through the Platform to the Service Agent-Coordinator









